



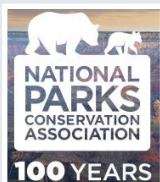

Day 1

Vancouver, BC

Our long-anticipated journey starts today with a flight to Vancouver.

Day 2 B, D

Vancouver, BC

Board the *Celebrity Millennium*, our home for the next seven nights.

Day 3 B, L, D

Inside Passage

Alaska's Inside Passage offers opportunities to see whales, otters, eagles and other wildlife against the backdrop of forests and fjords. Peaceful waters make this a great place to start.

Day 4 B, L, D

Ketchikan, AK

Once a rowdy fishing village, Ketchikan still has its own flavor. Walk Married Man's Trail or the notorious Creek Street to get a feel for life here during its heyday.

Day 5 B, L, D

Icy Strait Point, AK

Simple villages dot the entire Alaska coastline. Icy Strait Point is home to a salmon cannery that is open for tours to help us learn about this way of life.

Day 6 B, L, D

Juneau, AK

Alaska's state capital, inaccessible by car, still retains some of its frontier atmosphere. Meander through downtown, never tiring of the beautiful scenery that abounds in this state.

Day 7 B, L, D

Skagway, AK

The gateway to the goldrush, Skagway's history is fascinating and brutal. The small downtown is the hub for many optional excursions that can bring you deeper into the culture and climate of early settlers.

Day 8 B, L, D

Hubbard Glacier, AK

Nothing can compare with the peaceful blue of a glacier face. Spend time in the presence of Alaska's longest tidewater glacier, Hubbard Glacier, today. Suspense builds until a crashing wall of ice calves from the glacier, causing thunder to explode.

Day 9 B

Anchorage, AK

Disembark at Seward today, a quaint little town at the base of Mt. Marathon. Explore the *Alaska Sealife Center*, the state's premier facility dedicated to preserving sea life. Educational exhibits show fascinating aspects of local wildlife, and we'll have a special encounter with puffins during an expanded puffin program. Board a coach for one of the most scenic drives in the country, along Turnagain Arm. Dall Sheep graze on the cliffs to the right as Beluga whales surface on the cool water to the left, the mountains of the Kenai Peninsula looming in the distance. Stop along the way for a trip upward on the *Alyeska Resort Tram*. Enjoy views of the Turnagain Arm, up to seven "hanging" glaciers and endless peaks deep into the Chugach Mountain range from the top of this popular ski mountain.

Day 10 B, L

Anchorage, AK

After a *trolley tour* featuring Anchorage's distinctive downtown, surrounded by the Chugach Mountains and the Knik Arm, tour *The Ulu Factory*. This unique knife, leftover from the ancient Eskimo culture, is one of Alaska's most noteworthy items. After lunch, discover what people have been doing here for over a thousand years, surviving the harsh climate with ingenuity. Visit the *Alaska Native Heritage Center* for an appreciation their fascinating culture.

Day 11 B

Denali National Park, AK

Board the *Alaska Railway* that will take us to the interior, enjoying land scenery to rival last week's ocean views. Spend the first of two nights snug on the lower slopes of Sugarloaf Mountain.

Day 12 B, L

Denali National Park, AK

Take the *Kantishna Wilderness Trail* into the heart of Denali National Park. A scenic stretch of snow-capped mountains and verdant green valleys give us plenty of picture opportunities, and our relaxed pace leaves time to breathe in that crisp, clean air.

Day 13 B

Fairbanks, AK

Arrive in Fairbanks this afternoon, where the winter chill stays indoors all year long. The *Ice Museum* showcases the artistic efforts of ice sculptors, who we can watch work today. This craft is taken very seriously in Fairbanks, and the competition is fierce.

Day 14 CB, L

Fairbanks, AK

This morning, board the *Riverboat Discovery* for a cruise into the heart of Alaska through the eyes of a family celebrating four generations of history on the river. Enjoy a delicious lunch after the cruise.
