Day 1 Vancouver, BC
The long-awaited adventure to Alaska begins with a flight to Vancouver today.

Day 2 CB, D Vancouver, BC
Board **Holland America's Westerdam** and prepare to set sail. This award-winning cruise ship offers a front-row seat to Alaska's splendor with its wraparound decks and onboard enrichment programs.

Day 3 B, L, D Inside Passage
Alaska's Inside Passage is a protected network of waterways that wind through glacier-cut fjords and lush temperate rain forests along the rugged coast of Southeast Alaska. Arguably one of the greatest cruising routes in the world, the Inside Passage stretches through stunning landscapes. Sailing the Inside Passage offers opportunities to spot some of Alaska's most iconic wildlife, with humpback whales and orca plying the bountiful waters alongside the ships, bald eagles soaring overhead and brown bears lumbering on the shoreline.

Day 4 B, L, D Ketchikan, AK
Once a rowdy fishing village, Ketchikan still has its own flavor. Alaska's "First City" is so named because it's the first major landfall for most cruisers as they enter the picturesque fjords of the Inside Passage, where the town clings to the banks of the Tongass Narrows, flanked by green forests nurtured by abundant rain.

Day 5 B, L, D Juneau, AK
Juneau, Alaska may well be the most remote, most beautiful and strangest state capital in the United States. Surrounded by water, forest and mountain sights, visitors seeking things to do in Juneau indoors and outdoors can hike a glacier, eat fresh-caught fish on a seaside patio and tour a grand capitol building all in one day.

Day 6 B, L, D Skagway, AK
At the height of the Klondike Gold Rush, the port town of Skagway served as the primary gateway to the legendary gold fields, and quickly grew into Alaska's largest settlement. It was then a raucous frontier hub packed with trading posts, saloons and guesthouses. As the gold rush faded into the 1900s, so did Skagway—but today it has been reinvigorated as a gateway for a new kind of visitor: those looking to explore Alaska's colorful history, pristine wildlife and unrivaled natural beauty.

Day 7 B, L, D Glacier Bay
A bald eagle glides overhead when, in a flash, the silence is broken by the boom of a calving glacier or breath-catching splash of a breaching humpback. Glacier Bay National Park & Preserve offers some of the most dramatic scenery and wildlife experiences in all of North America—which makes all the more reason for you to visit with Holland America. Get an in-depth look at Glacier Bay before your ship even arrives with the cruise line's onboard enrichment programs. Become immersed in the national park's natural history and Native Tlingit heritage through multimedia presentations and engaging talks.

Day 8 B, L, D Gulf of Alaska
Enjoy a leisurely day of cruising as we cross the Gulf of Alaska. Marvel at the stunning shoreline that was sculpted by glaciers.

Day 9 B, L Seward, AK
Disembark in Seward today, a small town at the base of Mt. Marathon and ground zero for the Iditarod National Historic Trail. However, our time on the water is not over just quite yet. Visit an active tidewater glacier as we cruise through **Kenai Fjords National Park**. Journey up the coast from Seward and witness towering walls of rock, lush forests, tumbling glaciers and abundant wildlife. Onboard, a National Park Ranger provides local insight and points out seals, sea otters and sea lions playing on rocky shores. Look out for puffins and eagles soaring above. Wonder at the sight of magnificent whales at sea. An Alaskan-style lunch is included.

Day 10 CB Anchorage, AK
Get up close and personal with some of Alaska's most famous residents on a **dog sled ride and tour**. Gain an understanding of these famous sled dogs and puppies. The homestead displays what it takes to live in the wilderness, and how huskies become champions. Board an **Aerial Tram** and enjoy a breathtaking view of Turnagain Arm, hanging glaciers and endless snow-capped peaks from the top of **Mt. Alyeska**. This afternoon, make our way to historic Anchorage for the first of a two-night stay.

Day 11 CB, L Anchorage, AK
After a **trolley tour** featuring Anchorage's distinctive downtown, surrounded by the Chugach Mountains and the Knik Arm, visit **The Ulu Factory**. This unique knife, leftover from the ancient Eskimo culture, is one of Alaska's most noteworthy items. Take your seats for a hearty lunch at a local favorite. This afternoon, discover how people survived the harsh climate with ingenuity and cooperation for over a thousand years. Visit the **Alaska Native Heritage Center** for an appreciation of these fascinating cultures.
