## Day 5 B, L, D George Town, Cayman

Grand Cayman is one of a group of three magnificent tropical islands that Christopher Columbus called "Las Tortugas" (the turtles) for the sea creatures he found in the ocean water. The designation did not endure, however, on later maps the islands were labeled the Caimanau, the Carib Indian word for "crocodile." The name "Caimanas" refers inaccurately to the iguanas native to the islands, which were perhaps at one point mistaken for crocodiles. Among other attractions, visitors to the island will enjoy learning about the turtles, visiting the town of Hell, exploring Seven-Mile Beach and the undersea world.

## Day 6 B, L, D Falmouth, Jamaica

Today wake up in Falmouth, half-way between Montego Bay and Kingston, Jamaica. Falmouth has great restaurants, renowned shopping, and an endless array of leisure activities. Ride horseback through Caribbean waters along a white-sand beach or visit Dunn's River Falls. Perhaps you would prefer to simply relax on the beach. And with the friendly hospitality of the Jamaican people, having a great time is always "no problem".

## Day 7 B, L, D At Sea

Spend a day at sea relaxing after three full days of sightseeing. Sleep-in and then eat all day if you'd like!
