



Sunny Sedona

Nestled between the massive, fire-hued rocks of Red Rock State Park and the lush gorges of Oak Creek Canyon, Sedona is named one of the 10 most beautiful places in America by USA today. Escape from the winter weather and experience the natural beauty and rich culture of the southwest on this week-long adventure.

Day 1 D Santa Rosa, NM
Today the Southwest adventure begins as we make our way to the Land of Enchantment. Enjoy **dinner** this evening.

Day 2 CB, D Flagstaff, AZ
Welcome to the sunny southwest! Get to know your fellow passengers we travel to Arizona today. Arrive in Flagstaff and visit the renowned **Lowell Observatory** for a behind-the-scenes tour of the facility's high-powered telescopes. Sitting on top of Mars Hill Mesa, this observatory has been home to many discoveries, including the first detection of the expanding nature of the universe; the discovery of Pluto and its atmosphere; moon mapping for the Apollo moon mission; the rings of Uranus and many more. Tonight, enjoy a truly unique dining experience at the lively **Black Bart's Steakhouse & Saloon**.

Day 3 CB, D Sedona, AZ
Nature's beauty surrounds us this morning as we drive through **Oak Creek Canyon**, a sixteen-mile-long canyon on our way to Sedona. Described as the Grand Canyon's little sister, the gorge's red rock buttes tower against the clear blue sky. Experience the South side of Sedona on a **narrated trolley tour**. Enjoy spectacular views surrounding red rock desert and some of the area's most memorable vistas. Visit the iconic **Chapel of the Holy Cross**, constructed in the 1940's, this prominent landmark is rated one of the most awe-inspiring holy places to visit by National Geographic. The chapel stands at 250 feet tall, atop a 1,000 feet rock wall, featuring a stained-glass window is held together by a giant cross. Set amongst the red-hued rocks, Sedona is your home for the next three nights.

Day 4 CB, L Sedona, AZ
This morning, visit the old mining town of **Jerome**, located near the top of Cleopatra Hill. Once known as the "Wickedest Town in the West", Jerome was born a copper mining camp, growing from a settlement of tents into a roaring mining community. Learn the story of three prospectors who staked claims on rich copper deposits in the Arizona hills in 1876 during our visit to the **Jerome State Historic Park**. Our unforgettable scenery continues as we journey to Clarksdale to step aboard the **Verde Canyon Railroad**. Be captivated by this unspoiled canyon that takes you between two national forests, past crimson cliffs, over old fashioned trestles and through a 680-foot tunnel. Lunch is included on this spectacular scenic experience.

Day 5 CB, L Sedona, AZ
Spectacular scenery and panoramic views awaits us this morning as we venture off-road on a **Jeep Tour** through the majestic red rock country. Explore landforms millions of years in the making and learn about native landscape, wildlife and geological history, all set against a stunning backdrop of towering cliffs. Keep an eye open for desert wildlife. This afternoon, go in-depth and learn about the proud area legacy at the **Sedona Heritage Museum**, located inside Jordan Historical Park. Venture through the museum's exhibits highlighting the early settlers, ranching and cowboys, the orchard industry - and even movies made in Sedona. Later, visit Uptown Sedona and the Spanish-Mexican Village of **Tlaquepaque** to explore these wonderful areas full of art galleries shopping opportunities and restaurants.

Day 6 CB Santa Rosa, NM
What happens when an asteroid traveling 26,000 miles-per-hour collides with planet Earth? Find out during a visit to the world's best preserved impact site, **Meteor Crater**. Witness the breathtaking result of a collision that happened approximately 50,000 years ago and created a hole measuring nearly one mile across and more than 550 feet deep.

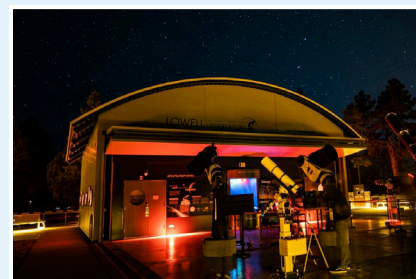
Day 7 CB Home
